How? By composting! Meat, bones, paper products such as napkins and paper towels (plastic-free only) can all be composted with Black Earth's curbside compost pick up. And if you **deep fry your bird**, Black Earth will even take the liquid grease. Pour it in a bottle and they will empty the bottle in the truck.
